Speech competition rules and regulations

We will be having a speech competition at the Supplementary school on Friday 21st April 2017 at 4.45pm - 6.45pm for weekday students and on Saturday 22nd April 2017 from 11.30am-1.30pm for weekend students where parents will be welcome to attend.

There will be 3 categories age wise.

- a. Students aged 7 years and below. The categories will be Nasheed, Quran recitation and English speech.
- b. Students aged 8-11 years in primary school. The categories will be Nasheed, English speech and Power point presentation.
- c. Students aged 11 -15 years at secondary school. The categories will be Nasheed, English speech and power point presentation.

English speech

The theme for the English speeches and PowerPoint presentations will be "**MY ROLE MODEL IN ISLAM AND WHY**".

This will involve a talk on role models from Islamic history which can include companions of the prophet PBUH, family of the prophet PBUH and other prominent men or women in the history of Islam but NOT any of the prophets.

English speeches can be provided to students and will be available on our website and also from the reception at the mosque. In the first stage the speech should be maximum 2 minutes.

Power point presentation

Power point presentation first stage will be done by sending the presentation through to the email address: school@khizramasjid.org

The presentation should have your full name, age and class name on the first slide. The presentation should be five slides only. The slides should cover details about your role model in Islam, why they are your role model and one famous short story/hadith about them. You will be judged on content and style of presentation for the first stage.

Quran recitation and Nasheed

Quran recitation and Nasheed can be of your own choice with maximum length of 3 minutes for the first stage.

Art and writing poster

This competition is open to all students at the supplementary school and will be judged as per age categories for speech competition but will be for all students at that age. This can also be entered by students who are taking part in other competitions and students can take part in both competitions.

The deadline for this competition is Friday 12th May 2017 at 6.45pm. Please hand over the posters and poems to your supplementary school tutors.
